
10 Ways to Use a BIGmack

1. Use to play games - "I win", "Your turn"
2. Request physical contact - "Brush my hair", "Rub my arm"
3. Tell everyone what's next - "Hey, it's lunchtime", "Let's go for a walk"
4. Request an activity - "Let's read a book", "Let's listen to a tape"
5. Put it in the bathroom - "I'm finished", "I need help"
6. Record a repetitive word or phrase from a story - "What do you see?"
7. Use during snack to make a choice or comment - "I want more", "That's yucky!"
8. Place on outside or inside the door - "Hello, how are you?", "Goodbye"
9. Record the day or date so that the child can answer the questions for circle time
10. Give directions in an activity - "Pour it", "Stir it"
